In keeping with the professional nature of this event, auditionee's and their parents (if under 18) will be asked to sign a contract indicating they understand that once rehearsals start **there can be zero schedule conflicts**. If challenges arise, participants may be removed from the cast.

***If cast, company members will receive scripts and be expected to memorize their parts by the time they arrive at camp on July 14.**

***Cast members may be called in on occasion prior to July for costume fittings or photo shoots.**

*** Cast members may register for Optional College Credit if desired. More info to follow once cast.**
